dating through letters, we can now look back and watch that blending. We can learn from it. The narrations are not shy about pointing out difficulties that arose throughout the 44 years since those letters were written. Those narratives are used by the author to emphasize life lessons the couple have learned through the tragedies and joys of their life experiences and are intended to be used as tools for other couples struggling with marriage issues. The author believes that sometimes old beliefs need to be restated. Maybe they are only old beliefs...lost values because our generation stopped communicating them.
